Bavaria Week, August 2nd – 9th, 2026
program

Sunday, August 2nd, 7:00 PM: Welcome dinner

Restaurant Zum Sollner Hirschen, Sollner Str. 43 - take the S-Bahn to Donnersberger Brücke station, change there to the S7 towards Wolfratshausen, 11 min journey to Solln station, from there a 3 min walk. _____

Monday, August 3rd: At Lake Starnberg

Take the S-Bahn to Possenhofen. We'll hike along Lake Starnberg, then climb through the Waldschmidt Gorge to Lake Deixlfurt, and from there continue to Ilkahöhe (where we'll stop for refreshments at a beer garden). The descent leads to Tutzing. Return by S-Bahn.

HU: approx. 200 m, WZ: approx. 4 ½ hours, approx. 15 km, Diff: easy

TP: 9:00 a.m., S-Bahn platform Donnersberger Brücke, track 1, middle section, departure S6 towards Tutzing at 9:14 a.m.

Tuesday, August 4th: In the southern Isar Valley: To the Lenggrieser Hütte (1338 m)

Bus trip to Lenggries. From the Hohenburg Castle parking lot, we first hike into the Mühlbach valley and then, increasingly steeply, through the forest to the Lenggrieser Hütte mountain hut, where we will stop for refreshments. Our return route takes us past the Seekar alpine pastures and down the Sulzersteig trail, where we pass two waterfalls and then hike back down into the valley to our starting point.

HU: 640 m, WZ: approx. 4 ½ hrs., 11 km, Schw: medium,

Leaders: Yra and Wolfgang Sch.

Alternative: From the Hohenburg Castle parking lot, walk past the castle ponds to the Reiterbach stream, then follow it to the Tratenbach stream. Follow this on a comfortable, steadily ascending forest path. After gaining altitude, the trail leads through the forest to the Denkalm alpine pasture (970 m). There you can stop for refreshments or enjoy a picnic.

Beautiful viewpoint. Descent and return via Calvary Hill to the parking lot.

Wednesday, August 5th: Excursion to Eichstätt in the Altmühl

Valley . Bus trip to Eichstätt. From the bus parking lot near the city center, we will first walk up to Willibaldsburg Castle, which offers a beautiful view of the episcopal city. We will visit the bastion garden, the "Hortus Eystettensis," a former botanical garden commissioned by the Prince-Bishop of Eichstätt during the Renaissance. After descending, we will stop for lunch. Those who prefer a picnic will find a pleasant spot in the park along the Altmühl River.

Afterwards, a city tour will take us to see the most important churches (cathedral and Church of the Guardian Angels), the baroque episcopal residence, but also modern architecture in the city and at the university.

Thursday, August 6: Ammergau Alps: To the Laber (1682 m),

Bus trip to Ettal/Oberammergau. From Ettal, we hike over the Laber mountain to Oberammergau. The ascent leads through shady woods on a sometimes steep path with fairly high steps to the Laberhaus mountain hut. There, we can have a picnic or stop for refreshments. We continue via Seilsee lake to the "Bärenbad" (Bear Bath) and the valley station of the Laber cable car; only a few more steep sections remain.

HU: 800 m, WZ: approx. 5 hrs., Schw: medium,

Leaders: Anne and Martina

Alternative: We start from Oberammergau through the picturesque Graswang Valley. About halfway along the route, we stop at the Gröbl-Alm mountain hut and then continue on to Linderhof Palace with its beautiful palace gardens.

HU: approx. 250 m; WZ: approx. 3 hrs., 12 km, Schw.: easy

Friday, August 7th: At Tegernsee: Hike to the Neureuth (1265

m), bus ride to Gmund. We will start together at the train station in Gmund, walk along the lake to "Seeglas," and then a gentle climb to the point where the two groups will separate. We will then continue hiking to the Neureuth. At the top, we will stop for refreshments or have a picnic. Descent to Tegernsee.

HU: 530 m, WZ: 4 hrs., Schw: medium

The alternative group continues hiking along the high-altitude trail to Tegernsee. In Tegernsee, there is free time (swimming, refreshments, a visit to the art museum).
